





AMI 3-6 Diploma Course in Estonia 2021-2023

AMI Montessori training gives you a possibility to gain an internationally recognised diploma for working in a Montessori environment with 3–6 year old children. Some countries may have their additional educational requirements for working in early childhood education. You will become a knowledgeable adult who supports the child in reaching their full developmental potential and becoming a lifelong learner. You will experience both intellectual and practical learning. Theory and hands-on work with the materials alternates during the course. In addition, you will practice observation and teaching in authentic Montessori groups.

Aims:

To provide the students with a deep understanding of Montessori theory, the Montessori materials and their function as aids to child development.

The student will learn to apply the knowledge of the method in their work in the future.

Course language:

- English with Estonian interpretation;
- obligatory reading in English (or other language if the books are available to use);
- written works and albums in English or in Estonian;
- practice in kindergarten groups in English or in any other language that is fluent for the participant;
- written and oral exams in English (or Estonian with the help of the interpreter).

Additional information:

- If you withdraw from the course before starting 20.09.2021 you need to pay the registration fee and the first installment.
- In case of quitting the course the already paid installments will not be returned.
- If the student withdraws from the course after 31 of May 2022 the whole payment is required.
- Course dates may be changing before the course starts or during the course, the organizer will inform you at first chance.
- If the course will be cancelled, the registration fee will be returned.

Enrollment criteria: Students need to have an adequate level of spoken and written English. Ability to study at a higher academic level and read the obligatory books. Positive motivation to study and willingness to positively and constructively cooperate with the Course Director and the organizer of the course. Preferably, the participant has acquired or is in the process of acquiring higher education.

Requirements for finishing the course and gaining an international AMI Diploma:

The mandatory parts:

- Written and oral exams (during last module)
- Observation and teaching practice at Montessori preschools
- Written essays
- Montessori material manuals and some handmade materials (language, culture etc.)
- Full payment
- Attendance 90%

Practice

90 hrs observation and 120 hours teaching practice in Montessori 3–6 environment with AMI trained guide.

In Estonia there are some opportunities for practice in Estonian or in Russian.

But there are English-speaking kindergartens in many other countries worldwide and if there are Montessori kindergartens in your country of residence, you can have practice in your language environment.
